First off, let's talk in years and months. From what we see here, they got a whopping 4 years and 2 months of experience with Google Cloud Platform (GCP), which is what we need for our Solutions Architect spot. In addition to this, they also show a solid experience of 9 years and 8 months with large-scale data platforms/solutions. They weren't light on data warehousing, ETL, and 81 services either, they got 4 years and 2 months on that. Then there's a nice add-on of their hands-on experience of 3 years and 5 months with cloud data management patterns. What's more, their leadership skills speak for themselves, boasting a hefty 8 years and 7 months. Taking all this into consideration, they've got most of the boxes ticked off our requirements list. A couple of areas could use a little beefing up, but overall, this candidate is cookin' with gas for the nosition.
